Parade Rules and Regulations

1. To ensure proper space allotment, we require the completed application no later than **Aug. 1, 2017**.
2. Parade will begin and end at the Rink parking lot.
3. All entries must be physically able to maintain the parade pace.
4. All drivers must have a valid driver's license. All entries must allow a driver a 180 degree view of the route at all times. All entries must have direct communication with the driver, whether they are attached or not. Proper ventilation is a must.
5. Ample supervision of children must be provided, prior to and during the Parade. The ratio being a minimum of 1 adult to 8 children.
6. All units carrying people must be equipped with adequate restraining devices that can reasonably be considered capable of stopping anyone from falling from the unit due to sudden stops.
7. If generators, lighting/ special effects are used, a Fire Extinguisher must accompany the float.
8. For safety reasons, **candy or advertising items may only be handed out** along the parade route. Under no circumstances will throwing items from vehicles be allowed. To ensure the comfort and safety of all spectators viewing the parade, **water guns, water balloons, or apparatus that shoot water or other material are strictly prohibited**.
9. Those who wish to bike, skateboard, rollerblade, scooter, use ATV's etc. during the Parade must wear proper protective equipment, especially helmets. They may not be towed by a vehicle.
10. Members of the Committee have the right to pull the Livestock entry off the route at the first suitable location if the managing of any livestock become a problem.
11. If at any time, the Committee has concerns regarding your entry such as safety, or any other reason that may seem unsuitable, the Committee has the right to remove your entry from the parade.
12. All applicants must assume liability relating to or arising from their involvement in the 150 Celebration Parade. The applicant will hold the Town of Preeceville and its volunteers harmless of any and all claims, actions or causes arising from their participation.
13. In the event of an EMERGENCY, Parade participants must move to the RIGHT of the Parade route to allow clear access for Emergency Vehicles. In the event of a large emergency and the parade must stop, turn into the nearest intersection to your right and cautiously proceed back to the original starting point.
14. All vehicles and debris must be removed from the Rink Parking lot by sundown.
15. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden in any float, in any vehicle or on the person of any participant.
16. Entries depicting violence, drugs, illegal activities or material deemed unsuitable for general public are not allowed.
