### YARD DEBRIS ON PRIVATE AND PUBLIC PROPERTY

Please be advised that grass clippings, leaves and yard debris are not to be dumped on public or private property within Town. This type of material is to be taken to the Regional Landfill.

### ELM TREE PRUNING BAN

Each year between April 1<sup>st</sup> and August 31<sup>st</sup>, the Elm Tree Pruning Ban is implemented by the Government of Saskatchewan to prevent the spread of Dutch Elm Disease. For more information on Dutch Elm Disease Control Regulations, contact 1-800-SASK ELM (727-5356).

### BUILDING PERMITS

With the building and renovation season underway, the Town of Preeceville would like to remind everyone that development and building permits are required for most new construction projects and renovations to existing buildings or land and for changes of buildings or land use. These permits ensure your project complies with the Municipal Zoning Bylaw and the National Building Code. ### ANNUAL NOTICE TO CONSUMERS

The Town of Preeceville is required by the Ministry of Environment to provide water consumers with a drinking water quality and compliance report each year. This report states the quality of water produced and supplied by the Town as well as information on the performance of the waterworks in submitting samples as required by the Minister's Order or Permit to Operate a waterworks. The Town's 2014 report has been compiled and is now available for pick up at the Town Office.

### OFFICE AND SHOP HOURS OF OPERATION

The Town Office and Maintenance Shop will be closed Monday, August 3rd for the Civic Holiday and on Monday, September 7th for the Labour Day Holiday. Regular business hours are Monday to Friday 8am to 12 noon and 1 pm to 5pm.

### PRWMA REGIONAL LANDFILL

The Regional Landfill Site, located west of Town at SE-4-35-6-W2nd in the RM of Preeceville is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm and every Saturday from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. ### ECO CENTRE IS OPEN!

The Eco Centre is now open for the 2015 season. The Eco Centre is open from 8:00 am – 12:00 noon every Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday. You can drop off all of your used oil, oil filters and containers free of charge. The ECO Centre also accepts pure antifreeze and diesel exhaust fluid containers. Think of it as your "green" contribution to our environment!

### ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES

Please be reminded that it is illegal to operate any unlicensed vehicle such as ATV's on public property and on private property without the owner's permission. However, in accordance with the Town's ATV Bylaw No. 3-2013, if you are exiting Town with your ATV you must use the most direct route possible from your residence to the closest exit out of Town and you may travel on or across a back alley or street for this purpose only. If you see someone violating these rules please contact the RCMP at (306) 563-4700. Also, please be reminded that a crop has been seeded on the land south west of Maple Farm Equipment as a Fundraising project for the Hospital. PLEASE AVOID USING THIS LAND as your ATV route out of town.

### GREEN SPACES

Community green spaces include all lands owned by the town. Open space areas include right of ways, boulevards, parks, pathways, floodplains, roadway medians, buffer strips, public walkways, and some utility parcels of land. Each community is mandated to have a percentage of all land used as green spaces. No one shall cause or allow an encroachment or amenity of any kind to be placed on these green spaces without the approval of the town. (Parking or storing anything.)
