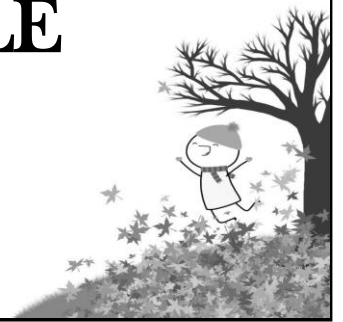

WATER AND SEWER RATE INCREASES

Please be advised that water and sewer rates will be increasing effective October 1st, 2017 in accordance with Bylaw No. 6 – 2016 as follows:

Residential Water Rates: 6,000 gallons or less- \$122.00 and \$5.36 per 1000 gallons after 6,000 per 3-month period.

Residential Sewer Rates- \$34.00 per 3-month period. Water service deposit fees will remain at \$200.00 and re-connection fees will remain at \$40.00. This rate increase will be reflected on the utility bills to be received January 1st, 2018.

FALL WATER LINE FLUSHING

Fall water line flushing will be taking place October 2nd to October 6th, dependant on weather conditions. Please watch the community sign and the local newspaper for any changes.

GARBAGE PICK UP

Those residents who have been instructed to move garbage for winter pickup from the back alleys to the front of your property are reminded to do so as of November 6th. If you are unsure if you are to move your garbage, please call the Town Office at 306-547-2810.

PRWMA REGIONAL LANDFILL

The Regional Landfill Site, located west of Town at SE-4-35-6-W2nd in the RM of Preeceville is open every Tuesday and Thursday from 3:00 pm to 7:00 pm until October 1st and then will change to 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm for winter hours. ABILITY VAN

The Preeceville Ability Bus Board has available for rent an Ability Bus and Van. The van is equipped with a wheelchair ramp, and is able to seat two wheelchairs, one passenger and the driver or one wheelchair and three passengers plus the driver. There is a minimum charge of \$10.00 per booking and \$0.42/km for the van. The bus has the capacity of four wheelchairs and six passengers or three wheelchairs and eight passengers.
